Re: Public Records Act Request, Dated October 22, 2019

Dear Ms. Cunningham:

We are in receipt of your Public Records Act Request dated October 22, 2019, requesting documents regarding the following:

1. Ridership data of all SMART systems including number of passengers.
2. Train repair schedules.
3. Maintenance logs.
4. Any communication relating to taking trains offline or bringing them online due to maintenance or staff decisions, either planned or unforeseen.
5. Request for proposal (RFP) for wifi on SMART trains, documents discussing the creating of a wifi RFP, wifi needs and capabilities, and all documents relating to the contract awarded for wifi on trains.

Requests numbers 3 and 4 are overbroad and fail to describe a reasonably identifiable record to enable SMART to determine what documents you seek as is required by the Act. (Gov't Code § 6253(b).) Please clarify these requests.

The disclosable documents responsive to your remaining requests are being searched for. SMART will also review whether any of the documents you have requested are exempt from disclosure, these may include:

1. Preliminary drafts pursuant to Government Code Section 6254(a).
2. Information and/or data relating to a railroad's risk analysis and/or sensitive security information. See Government Code Sections §§ 6255, 6254(k), and 6254.23; Evidence Code § 1040; 49 U.S.C. 20118; and 49 CFR Parts 15 and 1520.

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3. Information exempt from disclosure pursuant to the deliberative process privilege.
4. Trade secrets pursuant to Government Code Section 6254(a); Evidence Code § 1060.
5. Confidential information protected by the attorney-client privilege or attorney work product doctrine. See Government Code Section 6254(k) and Evidence Code Section 950 et seq

Please contact SMART's Public Records Act Coordinator at (707) 285-8184 on or after November 15, 2019, to ensure the documents have been fully compiled and to obtain a determination for the total direct costs of duplication. Payment will need to be remitted to SMART prior to providing you with copies.
